 - a. Heavens
 - b. Earth- dirt, minerals
 - c. Water
 - d. Light=Day.
 - e. Darkness=Night
 2. Day Two Genesis 1:6-8
 - a. Divided waters
 - b. Firmament
 - c. Water
 3. Day Three Genesis 1:9-13
 - a. Gathered water covering the earth into one place
 - b. Made land to appear and plants to grow
 4. Day Four Genesis 1:14-19
 - a. Sun, moon, stars
 - b. Days, seasons, years
 5. Day Five Genesis 1:20-23
 - a. Birds
 - b. Fish
 6. Day Six Genesis 1:24-31
 - a. Mammals, reptiles, amphibians, insects

2. Sin Solution (Good News)

- a. What has GOD done about sin?
 - 1] Acts 16:31
 - a] Promise – Gift of GOD - Loves us
 - b] Contract between GOD and man
 - 2] Am I saved? The Bible says, “Yes!”
- b. What happens when we believe? (36 things)
 - 1] Member of GOD'S Family - never changes
 - 2] In fellowship with GOD - changes
- c. What happens when we sin after we are saved?
(I John 1:9)
 - 1] Sin takes us out of fellowship
 - 2] Using I John 1:9 puts us back into fellowship
 - a] Confess (name, tell) sins to GOD the Father
 - b] The FATHER forgives known and unknown sins

- d. How do we confess our sins to GOD the Father?
 - 1] Talking to GOD (Prayer)
 - 2] Five parts of Prayer
 - a] “Dear Heavenly Father”
 - b] Tell (confess) sins (I John 1:9)
 - c] Talk to GOD
 - 1) Thanks and praise
 - 2) Other peoples’ needs
 - 3) Your own needs
 - d] “In JESUS’ Name”
 - e] “Amen”
