PASSAGE

Lesson 50: Hidden Treasure (Proverbs 2 - NKJV)

1. My son, **if** you receive my words,
And treasure my commandments within you,
2. So that you incline thine **ear** to wisdom,
And apply your heart to understanding;
3. Yes, if you cry out for discernment,
And lift up your voice for understanding;
4. If you **seek** her as silver,
And search for her as *for* hidden treasures;
5. Then you will understand the fear of the LORD,
And find the knowledge of God.
6. For the LORD **gives** wisdom;
From his mouth *come* knowledge and
understanding;
7. He stores up sound wisdom for the upright;
He is a shield to those who walk uprightly;
8. He guards the paths of justice,
And preserves the way of His saints.
9. **Then** you will understand righteousness and
justice,
Equity *and* every good path.
10. When wisdom enters your heart,
And knowledge is pleasant to your soul,
11. Discretion will **preserve** you,
Understanding will keep you,
12. To deliver you from the way of evil,
From the man who speaks perverse things;
13. From those who leave the paths of uprightness,
To walk in the ways of darkness;
14. Who rejoice in doing evil,
And delight in the perversity of the wicked;
15. Whose ways *are* crooked,
And *who are* devious in their paths:
16. To deliver you from the immoral woman,
From the seductress *who* flatters with her
words,
17. Who forsakes the companion of her youth,
And forgets the covenant of her God.
18. For her house leads down to death,
And her paths to the dead;
19. None who go to her return,
Nor do they regain the paths of life--
20. So you may walk in the way of goodness,
And keep to the paths of righteousness.
21. For the upright will dwell in the land,
And the blameless will remain in it;
22. But the wicked will be cut off from the earth,
And the unfaithful will be uprooted from it.

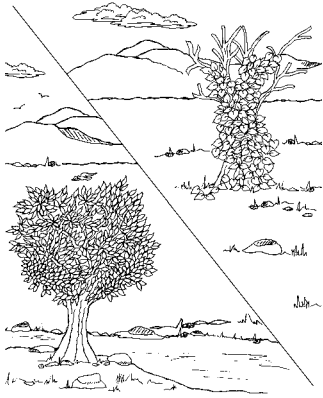

Psalm 1



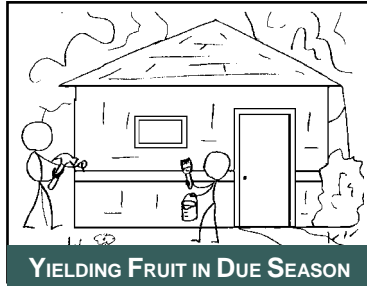
1. Blessed *is* the man

Deuteronomy 6:4-7 - Whet Their Appetites

4 "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD *is* one! 5 You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul and with all your strength. 6 And these words which I command you today shall be in your

heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.



Luke 10:38-42 - Martha and Mary

38 Now it happened as they went that He entered a certain village; and a certain woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house. 39 And she had a sister called Mary, who also sat at Jesus' feet and heard His word. 40 But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, do You

not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me." 41 And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. 42 But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

Hebrews 5:11-14 - Meal Time: Milk or Meat?

11 Of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing. 12 For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need *someone* to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid

foor. 13 For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe. 14 But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

Matthew 7:13-16 - Beware of Wolves

13 "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide *is* the gate and broad *is* the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. 14 Because narrow *is* the gate and difficult *is* the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

15 Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. 16 You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles?"

Deuteronomy 6:10-14 - Beware Lest You Forget

10 "So it shall be, when the LORD your God brings you into the land of which He swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give you large and beautiful cities which you did not build, 11 houses full of all good things, which you did not fill, hewn-out wells which you did not dig, vineyards and olive trees which you did not plant—when you have eaten

and are full— 12 *then* beware, lest you forget the LORD who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage. 13 You shall fear the LORD your God and serve Him, and shall take oaths in His name. 14 You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who *are* all around you

Deuteronomy 6:20-24 - When Your Children Ask

20 "When your son asks you in time to come, saying, 'What *is the meaning of* the testimonies, the statutes, and the judgments which the LORD our God has commanded you?' 21 *then* you shall say to your son: 'We were slaves of Pharaoh in Egypt, and the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand; 22 and the LORD showed signs and wonders before our eyes, great and

severe, against Egypt, Pharaoh, and all his household. 23 Then He brought us out from there, that He might bring us in, to give us the land of which He swore to our fathers. 24 And the LORD commanded us to observe all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as *it is* this day.
